NURSES

- Nurses protect, promote, optimize health, prevent illness and injury, and advocate for patients and their families.
- Nurses provide care in hospitals, homes, community clinics, and at schools.
- Nursing is the highest workforce amongst healthcare workers, and is considered one of the most admiring careers in America.
- Nursing is a career without borders, without color, and without gender difference.
- Nursing is about those whose father, mother, brother, sister, or child you
 have saved or care for on a daily basis.

DIVERSITY

- Minorities are needed in nursing.
- Only 6.6% of the nursing population are males, and only 16% are minorities.
- \geq 6.6% = 200,000 males out of 3.06 million licensed RN.
- \geq 16% = 490,000 minorities out of 3.06 million licensed RN.
- Hispanics are the fastest rising minority group in the US yet it only represents about 2% of the total nursing population (54,861).


